Research indicates that individuals with Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) are at high risk of becoming victims of bullying behaviour. This workshop will focus on analyzing bullying behaviour, identifying risk factors for individuals with ASD and creating individualized plans to assist individuals in identifying bullying behaviour and developing the skills necessary to help prevent and/or react effectively to the behaviour. The workshop will feature firsthand accounts, activities, questionnaires, and dynamic dialogue to strengthen participants' ability to take action.
